Application Details

Application method:	Brush / Roll / Airless Spray
Thinner:	Fresh water
Thinner Amount:	Brush (Do not Thin) – Roller (10%) - airless Spray (5%)

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Surface Preparation:

- Surface must be dry, clean and free of all contamination such as dirt, oil, grease, and coatings etc. which hinder adhesion.
- Surface must be firm and have enough strength. If in doubt, apply a test area before beginning.
- Weak concrete must be removed and surface defects such as blowholes and voids must be fully exposed.
- All dust, loose and friable particles should be removed from the surface before application with brush and/or vacuum cleaner.
- Grinding by diamond disk should take over the place and all the dust must be removed by vacuum machine.
- All the cracks must be repaired by Flexible Material.

Important Remarks:

- Surfaces must have enough structural strength.
- Concrete should have minimum of 25 N/mm² compression resistance and minimum 1, 5 N/mm² tensile strength.
- Applications below 10°C should be avoided.
- The surface should be protected from moisture and rain for 24 hours after application.
- All application tools and equipment should be cleaned with water immediately after the use. Cured material can only be removed mechanically.
- Use only where application and drying can proceed at temperatures above: 10°C/50°F. The temperature of paint itself should be 15°C/59°F or above.

Shelf life & Storage:

12 months from date of production if stored properly in original, unopened and undamaged sealed packaging in dry conditions at temperatures between +5°C and +30°C.
